

**Report of the Asia and the Pacific regional preparatory meeting for the third meeting
of the Conference of the Parties to the Minamata Convention on Mercury**

7 and 8 October 2019, Bangkok, Thailand

1. Overview

Asia and the Pacific regional meeting in Bangkok, Thailand, was attended by a total of seventy-three participants. Among these, forty-six participants represented twenty-four governments (China, India, Indonesia, Islamic Republic of Iran, Japan, Jordan, Kiribati, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Lebanon, Maldives, Myanmar, Philippines, Qatar, Samoa, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, State of Palestine, Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu, and Vietnam) in the region. The remaining twenty-seven participants represented two UN bodies (UNDP and UNEP), two Basel and Stockholm Convention regional centres, and fourteen NGOs.

Basel and Stockholm Convention Regional Centre for South-East Asia in Jakarta, Indonesia (BSCRC-SEA) supported the organization and logistics of the meeting as a partner. The meeting participants acknowledged the support provided by donors from Austria, Japan, the Philippines, Norway, and Sweden.

Mr. Mohammed Khashashneh (Jordan) and Mr. Mohsen Naziri Asl (Islamic Republic of Iran) co-chaired the meeting as they are the bureau members from the region.

2. Proceedings

The meeting was opened by the Co-Chairs. Ms. Dechen Tsering, Director and Regional Representative of UNEP's Asia and the Pacific Office, welcomed the meeting participants. Opening remarks were also delivered by Ms. Rossana Silva Repetto, Executive Secretary, Secretariat of the Minamata Convention on Mercury.

A number of Parties and other governments provided updates on their activities for the implementation of the Convention. The Secretariat provided an update of activities since COP2, and an overview of the general structure and programme for COP3. The Secretariat further introduced the documents for COP3. A number of clarifying questions were raised, to which the Secretariat responded and provided further information as necessary and requested.

An interactive and fruitful discussion took place throughout the meeting. During the meeting, the representative of UNEP's Law Division introduced the report of the Executive Director of the United Nations Environment Programme to the third meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Minamata Convention on Mercury (UNEP/MC/COP.3/INF/4). In addition, the representative of UNEP's Asia and the Pacific Office introduced a regional project titled "Promoting Minamata Convention on Mercury by making the most of Japan's knowledge and experiences", funded by the government of Japan.

The Co-Chairs and the Secretariat of the Minamata Convention delivered the closing remarks.
